Reports vary when it comes to pandas living in the wild, but the numbers could be as high as 3,000.

In the past, pandas were considered as noble and rare creatures. In fact, the mother of Emperor Wen of Han even had a panda skull placed in her vault when she was buried. Today, they are still considered fascinating creatures by the public and people flock to visit them in such places as the Atlanta and San Diego Zoo, two of the few places in the United States where pandas can be viewed up close.

Several of the Giant Panda check series send proceeds from the sales to conservation programs. For instance, one check series sends 5% of their proceeds to the San Diego Zoo where several pandas call home. These checks also feature four rotating scenes of Hua Mei, the first successful birth of a Giant Panda in the United States. The San Diego Zoo is committed to helping endangered species and their habitats and places an emphasis on conservation and research. The checks are printed on recycled paper.

The World Wildlife Fund is another respected conservation organization that is also championed by panda checks. It is recognized around the world for its popular panda logo and assists more than 100 countries when it comes to conservation programs.

Coordinating address labels and a matching checkbook cover that complements your checks can be purchased in addition to the panda checks as well.

If you want to buy panda checks, bear in mind that by getting them online from a reputable site you can save as much as 50% off the cost that you might have paid when purchasing them from your local bank. When buying your panda checks remember that you will need your routing number and checking account number handy so that they can be printed directly onto the checks. You should plan on getting them in around 3-5 days.
